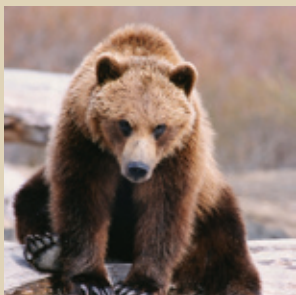
Wildlife and Spectacular Glaciers
